#### **New EB Tariff Explained**

Government of Karnataka announced the Gruha Jyoti free power programme, numerous news sources mentioned a significant increase in the price of electricity of Rs 2.89 per unit. The claims that rates increased by 50% were forwarded in social media groups, Understanding the various components of your electricity bill is crucial to start with.

#### **Basic Components the Bill**

- Fixed charges (FC): No matter how much electricity you use, you must pay a monthly fee depending on your authorised load or capacity. Usually, the fees are expressed in Rs/KW.
- Energy charges (EC): These are the costs associated with how much electricity you use. The typical charge is in rupees per unit, with one unit equaling one kilowatt-hour.
- Fuel adjustment charges (FAC): It makes up for cost differences experienced by electricity providers, such as those brought on by fluctuations in fuel prices.
- Additional Security Deposit (ASD): Minimum of two months' security deposit, in accordance with the sanctioned load.

#### **Previous Structure**

Fixed charges and energy charges were calculated based on four slabs. Before, there was a set fee of \*100 and an energy charge of \*4.15 per unit for individuals who consumed 0–50 units. The fixed charge for those who consumed 51 to 100 units was 110, and the energy charge was 5.60 per unit. For those who consumed 101–200 units, the fixed fee was \*175 and the energy fee was \*7.15 per unit.

#### **New Structure**

Those who consume 0 - 100 units would have to pay a fixed charge of 110 and energy charge of 4.75 per unit. The fixed fee is 210, and the energy charge is 7 per unit, for those who consume 0-All Units (which could be any amount within the sanctioned load).

However, those who qualify for the Gruha Jyothi scheme would not have to worry about the FPPCA, as the charge for the qualified quantum of power would be taken care of by the government.

#### **Yoga Day Celebration**



#### Say No to Soda

#### Hearing Aids May Reduce Cognitive Decline in Adults: Lancet Study

The findings are based on the first randomised controlled trial (RCT) of its kind involving nearly 1,000 older adults from multiple locations across the US.

Hearing aids may protect against cognitive decline in older adults at greater risk of dementia, according to a study published on Tuesday in The Lancet journal. Hearing aids may reduce cognitive decline in adults: Lancet study.

The findings are based on the first randomised controlled trial (RCT) of its kind involving nearly 1,000 older adults from multiple locations across the US. "These results provide compelling evidence that treating hearing loss is a powerful tool to protect cognitive function in later life, and possibly, over the long term, delay a dementia diagnosis," said Professor Frank Lin of Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine and Bloomberg School of Public Health, US.

"But any cognitive benefits of treating age-related hearing loss are likely to vary depending on an individuals' risk of cognitive decline," said Lin.

Age-related hearing loss is extremely common, affecting two-thirds of adults aged over 60 globally, the researchers said.

However, less than 1 in 10 individuals with hearing loss in low- and middle-income countries, and fewer than 3 in 10 in high-income countries, currently use hearing aids, they said.

Untreated hearing loss is associated with greater cognitive decline and was estimated by the 2020 Lancet Commission on Dementia to contribute to around 8 per cent of dementia cases worldwide -- equivalent to 8 lakh of the nearly 10 million new cases of dementia diagnosed every year.

Previous observational research suggests that treating hearing loss may protect against cognitive decline and dementia, the researchers said.

However, these studies may be biased because individuals who have the means and choose to get their hearing loss treated may be healthier and at lower risk of cognitive decline than those who don't, they said.

As a result, the effectiveness of hearing aid use on reducing cognitive decline in cognitively-healthy older adults with hearing loss remained unclear.

To provide more robust evidence, the latest study included 977 adults aged 7084 years with untreated hearing loss who were free from substantial cognitive impairment in four communities across the US.

Participants were recruited from two populations at each site: older adults participating in a longstanding observational study of cardiovascular health (Atherosclerosis Risk in Communities [ARIC] study), and new volunteers from the same communities who were generally healthier than participants from ARIC.

Participants were randomised to either a hearing intervention (audiological counselling and hearing aids) or the control intervention involving more generalised counselling on healthy ageing and were followed-up twice a year over 3 years.

The primary analysis of the results, combining both the ARIC and volunteer cohorts, found that the hearing intervention did not reduce cognitive decline over timewith no significant difference in cognitive change between those receiving the hearing intervention and the health education control over 3 years.

However, in the ARIC cohort, 3-year cognitive change was 48 per cent lower in the hearing intervention group than the control group.

In contrast, in the healthy volunteer cohort (who had fewer risk factors for cognitive decline and a much slower rate of cognitive decline), 3-year cognitive change did not differ significantly between the hearing intervention and control groups.

No significant adverse events were reported in either group.

"Although our primary analysis of the combined ARIC and health volunteer cohorts did not find a difference in cognitive decline for those using hearing aids, when we did sensitivity analyses totest its robustness there was clear evidence indicating a significant benefit for older adults in the

ARIC cohort who had more risk factors for cognitive decline," Lin said.

"Despite similar levels of hearing at the start of the study, it's likely that volunteers in the healthier cohort experienced slower rates of cognitive change than ARIC participants because they tended to be younger, had fewer risk factors for cognitive decline, and had better initial cognitive scores," he added.




#### **Cervical Cancer Prevention**

Cervical cancer is a type of cancer that develops in the cells of cervix (Lower most part of uterus). It is thesecond most common cause of cancer mortality in India. It is huge public health crisis for India, as 1 Indian women loses her life to cervical cancer every 8 minutes. This suffering is unacceptable particularly as cervical cancer is largely preventable. It is a cancer which is curable & preventable with early deduction and proper treatment.

As per a study conducted in India 41% of women are not aware of cervical screening test(PAP SMEAR – Test, for more information can refer to previous article written by me).

#### The most important thing you can do to prevent cervical cancer



#### What is HPV Vaccination?

As per WHO most of the cervical cancer is caused by Human Papilloma Virus(HPV). HPV transmission is influenced by sexual activity and age. Almost 75% of all sexually active adults are likely to be infected with at least 1 HPV type. However, Majority of them resolves spontaneously and minority <1% HPV infection progress to cancer.



2 Types of vaccines (Gardasil, Cervarix) against HPV licensed globally and available in India. If the vaccine is given to the girls before sexual exposure between 9-14 years it is more than 99% effective in preventing cervical cancer and also genital warts and other cancers caused by the same virus. This is given by intra muscular injection given in three doses with interval depending upon the vaccine types.

It can be simultaneously given along with other vaccines. At present no data on booster doses.

#### Side Effects:

No serious vaccine related adverts events have been reported, as the vaccine does not contain live virus. Most common side effects can be local pain, swelling and redness in the injection side.

Vaccine should be deferred in any acute illness.

Not recommended in pregnancy

Vaccine can be given in breast feeding women.

Should we continue cervical screening (PAP SMEAR) even after vaccination? Vaccines are not 100% protective against the cervical cancer and not a replacement for periodical screening.

Whom should we vaccinate? What is the ideal time?

Vaccination can be given to the females as young as 9 years as well as in those aged 13 -26 years Ideally before the sexual exposure.

We all work together to prevent cervical cancer by primary prevention(HPV vaccination) and by secondary prevention(PAP SMEAR) and spread the

information to create more awareness.


