3. Stri Suraksha reports violence against


Protecting our children is vital. As Nelson Mandela once suitably said, "The true character of a society is revealed in how it treats its children."

Children with autism often grapple with sensory challenges affecting their five senses: visual, auditory, tactile, vestibular, and proprioception. These sensory hurdles hinder their developmental milestones, impacting activities like running, jumping, sitting, and walking, essential for addressing their sensory needs. Proprioception and vestibular senses, central to gross motor development, become focal points.




Gross motor skills, integral from two months (head control) to four years (independent stair climbing), bolster balance, coordination, body awareness, motor planning, posture, and gravitational security. Acquiring foundational skills—standing, walking, running, and jumping—facilitates advanced abilities such as hopping, one-leg standing, and obstacle crossing, addressing and balancing sensory challenges.

Varying gross motor skill performance arises as autistic children adapt to meet sensory needs. Incorporating gross motor skills into autism therapy improves sensory equilibrium, aiding further development. Occupational therapists guide this process, making children functional by addressing sensory imbalances, enabling effective participation in daily tasks. This comprehensive approach fosters holistic development in children with autism.

### **IVF MADE EASY**

### WHAT IS IVE?

IVF aka In Vitro Fertilisation, in simple terms is the process of making an embryo (the future baby) in the lab.


### Who need IVF?

Couples who have either male factor issues like severe sperm abnormalities or female factors like fallopian tube blockade, ovulation disorders, endometriosis, underwent tubal ligation previously and now seek fertility are some of the indications.

In a few cases when both the partners have normal parameters, but still experience infertility , called as unexplained infertility, IVF has given very good results.

### What exactly is done in IVF?

So, for the fertilization to happen, we need male and female gametes. These are collected from both the partners and under strictly monitored conditions, they are fertilized in the lab to make an Embryo.



### How are the gametes collected?

The male partner has to give his semen sample. In cases where the sperms are less in number or even nil in the semen sample, they might need a tiny painless surgery to collect the sperms.

In case of a female, she will be given injections to stimulate her ovaries for the eggs to grow for about 12 days and a tiny surgery is done under anesthesia to collect her eggs.

### Why do we need multiple embryos, when we need just one baby?

Well,it isn't compulsory that just because we deposited one embryo,it gets implanted instantly.

The quality of the sperms,eggs and their product has to be good to get a good result. Plus,if one cycle fails,it adds lots of physical,emotional and financial burden on the couple to undergp the entire process again.

### Say, we got pregnant in the first instance, what will happen to the embryos?

The embryos will be frozen in the lab and they can be kept like that for 10yrs. If in the future you wish to go for a second child, these embryos can be used again

If you don't wish to preserve them, they will be discarded after your consent in taken.

### Is it expensive?

Well,it's a process where you have to recreate something that happens naturally inside the human body in a lab,so it requires quite some machinery to collect,fertilise the microscopic gametes,grow them and freeze them.

But, it has become quite affordable these days due to the latest advances that have come up in the past decade.

### When to consult a doctor?

If you have been trying to get pregnant for over an year, or your age is more than 30 and you have been trying for 6 months already, or you have a family history of fertility issues or you already have a baby but not able to conceive for the second time, you need to consult a Fertility specialist at the earliest.

You will be evaluated with basic tests and will be guided towards the best possible treatment

### Any advice?

Be patient, take care of your health, treat your body right with regular exercise, good food and no stress.

And most importantly, Trust your doctor.


