NEWS BITES

A massive blaze engulfed a chemical factory in Electronics City on June 28, 2026. Four fire tenders controlled the fire. No casualties were reported as the factory was closed. Investigation is underway

Karnataka's Energy Department announced July electricity bills will be calculated using the previous three-month average consumption to address concerns over revised tariffs.

BWSSB has banned the use of drinking water for washing vehicles, watering gardens, and construction activities across the city to conserve water amid below-normal rainfall and falling groundwater levels.

The state government said the Outer Ring Road upgrade plan will be finalised only after public consultation, inviting suggestions from residents and stakeholders.

NEELADRI ROAD: A DAILY OBSTACLE COURSE FOR PEDESTRIANS



ers occupying public space with handcarts, and broken or displaced footpath slabs further compound the problem. Together, these obstacles have turned what should be a safe pedestrian walkway into a daily hazard. Residents say the gap between policy and implementation is glaring. While authorities speak of protecting pedestrians' rights, the reality on Neeladri Road tells a different story.

“The need of the hour is swift, time-bound action to restore usable footpaths, remove encroachments, repair damaged infrastructure and ensure safe passage for pedestrians. Until then, walking along Neeladri Road will remain less of a commute and more of an obstacle course.”

The Supreme Court has reaffirmed that pedestrians, the most vulnerable road users, have the first right to safe and unobstructed footpaths. Echoing this, Greater Bengaluru Development Minister Krishna Byre Gowda recently stated that, from July 1, 2026, commercial establishments encroaching on pavements must remove extensions to restore space for pedestrians.

However, a walk along Neeladri Road paints a very different picture. For residents, especially senior citizens, parents with young children and school-going students, using the footpath is often impossible. Instead, they are forced onto the busy carriageway,

putting their safety at risk. The ongoing monsoon has only worsened the situation. Overflowing sewage, stagnant water and foul odour make several stretches of the footpath unusable. In many locations, ongoing civil works have blurred the boundary between the road and the pavement, while excavated sections leave pedestrians with little option but to walk alongside moving traffic. The situation is particularly alarming opposite Parameshwari Complex, where road widening and civil works have reduced the usable road width by nearly 30%, creating a dangerous bottleneck for both motorists and pedestrians. Bengaluru-Chennai Expressway Nears 100 km Milestone

Nearly 100 km of the Bengaluru-Chennai Expressway is now operational with the opening of a new 25-km stretch in Andhra Pradesh.

The new section is expected to reduce travel time and improve connectivity between Bengaluru and Chennai.

Electronic City Awaits Safe Footpath Campaign

The Greater Bengaluru Authority has cleared 202.7 km of footpaths across Bengaluru in the first three days of its Safe Footpath Campaign. Electronic City residents are now urging authorities to extend the drive to their area and remove encroachments for safer pedestrian access.

Karnataka Launches 'Beda Bro' Anti-Drug Campaign

The Karnataka government has launched 'Beda Bro', a statewide awareness campaign to help students stay away from substance abuse.

The initiative will reach schools and colleges through awareness drives, community outreach, and social media.

Booth Level Officers (BLOs) will visit households from 30 June to 29 July 2026 to verify voter details under the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) 2026.

Residents are requested to keep the required documents ready and cooperate to ensure their names are included in the electoral roll.

Yellow Line Nears Operational Readiness

BMRL is expected to receive all 15 trainsets by July 15, paving the way for 6-minute service frequency on the Yellow Line.

Vacant Plots May Earn 35-Year Tax Waiver

The Karnataka government has proposed property tax exemptions of up to 35 years for owners who convert vacant private land into public parking facilities.

The draft policy aims to ease Bengaluru's parking shortage and improve traffic management.

RESCUE MISSION LAUNCHED TO SAVE SHIKARIPALYA LAKE

Electronic City | July 2026: Authorities have begun a major rescue operation to restore Shikaripalya Lake after reports of severe pollution caused by untreated sewage inflows. Acting on directions from the Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department, Hulimangala Gram Panchayat has initiated immediate measures to prevent further environmental damage. Officials conducted site in-

spection, deployed vacuum tankers to remove accumulated sewage and stagnant wastewater, and started treating contaminated water. The Panchayat is also working with various government departments to identify the sources of illegal sewage discharge and ensure that untreated wastewater no longer enters the lake.

To strengthen enforcement, police complaints have been

filed against those responsible for polluting the lake. Authorities have assured residents that restoration efforts, regular monitoring, and pollution control measures will continue until the lake's ecological health is restored. The initiative aims to protect one of Electronic City's important water bodies and ensure its long-term sustainability for local communities and biodiversity.

CHILDREN AT RISK: ONE RIDE MAKES ALL THE DIFFERENCE

“JAGRUTI” CHILD SAFETY AWARENESS CAMPAIGN TO REACH ELECTRONIC CITY COMMUNITIES



As part of an upcoming child safety awareness campaign, a volunteer training session was conducted on 4 July 2026 at Samridhi Early Learning Center. The session brought together enthusiastic volunteers from diverse backgrounds, ranging in age from 20 to over 60 years, who came forward to support the cause of child protection. Lasting for more than five hours, the training was highly informative, interactive, and focused on preparing volunteers for community outreach. The training was conducted by Dr. Usha, a Psychiatric Social Worker from NIMHANS, covering

topics such as the POCSO Act, child rights, drug abuse prevention, the importance of education, and the functioning of the 1098 helpline. Volunteers also learned effective ways to engage with communities through positive conversations, street plays, and child-friendly activities.

The campaign, guided by the District Child Protection Office (DCPO), West Division, Bengaluru Urban District, Anekal, aims to spread awareness about child safety, children's rights, and the services provided by the DCPO. It also seeks to encourage children and adults to contact the Child

Helpline - 1098 whenever a child is in danger or needs support. The initiative is led by DCPO Officer Asha, with support from Mrs. Manishaji (Founder, SMSC Charitable Trust), Mrs. Neetu (Founder, Samridhi Early Learning Center), and Dr. Shipra Lamba (Senior Psychologist at Apollo and Cloudnine Hospitals). Media support will be provided by Electronic City Credence.

The campaign will cover the Electronic City area, with July's theme focusing on the safety and security of children of migrant workers, helping families understand where to seek timely support and protection.

BMRCL, BMTc LAUNCH METRO FEEDER BUS SERVICE CONNECTING ELECTRONIC CITY TO BENNIGANAHALLI



To improve first and last-mile connectivity for Metro commuters, the Bengaluru Metro Rail Corporation Limited (BMRCL), in coordination with the Bengaluru Metropolitan Transport Corporation (BMTc), has introduced a dedicated Metro feeder bus service between **Electronic City Wipro Gate and Tin Factory (Benniganahalli Metro Station)**.

The feeder bus will connect major residential, commercial and employment hubs along the route, including Elec-

tronic City, Konappana Agrahara, Hosa Road, Haralur, Sarjapura Road Junction, Kadubee-sanahalli, Marathahalli Bridge Junction, Dodanekundi Railway Station before reaching Benniganahalli Metro Station.

The service is aimed at making Metro travel more convenient by providing seamless connectivity to commuters travelling to and from Electronic City.

Departure Timings

from Electronic City Wipro Gate:

05:30, 06:00, 06:30, 07:00, 07:40, 08:20, 09:00, 10:20, 13:15, 14:00, 14:40, 15:10, 15:50, 16:30, 17:10, 17:50, 18:30, 19:10, 19:50, 20:30 and 21:10 hrs.

Departure Timings from Tin Factory (Benniganahalli Metro Station):

05:30, 06:00, 06:30, 07:00, 07:40, 08:20, 09:00, 09:40, 10:20, 11:00, 11:40, 12:10, 15:50, 16:30, 17:10, 17:50, 18:30, 19:10, 19:50, 20:30 and 21:10 hrs.

BMRCL has urged Metro users to make optimum use of these dedicated feeder buses, which are expected to reduce dependence on private vehicles and offer reliable, affordable and seamless last-mile connectivity across Bengaluru.

TOLL HIKE COMES INTO EFFECT ON E-CITY ELEVATED EXPRESSWAY, ATTIBELE TOLL PLAZA AND NICE ROAD FROM JULY 1

Commuters using the Electronic City Elevated Expressway, Attibele Toll Plaza and NICE Road have been paying revised toll charges since July 1, 2026, following the latest toll revision. While some fares remain unchanged, regular commuters making multiple trips or using monthly passes will see a noticeable increase in travel costs.

On the Electronic City Elevated Expressway (Silk Board-Electronic City), the

single journey toll for cars, jeeps and vans remains unchanged at ₹65. However, the same-day multiple journey toll has increased from ₹95 to ₹100, while the monthly pass has been revised from ₹1,885 to ₹1,960, an increase of ₹75. For two-wheelers, the single journey charge remains ₹25, the same-day return remains ₹40, while the monthly pass has increased from ₹755 to ₹785.

At the Attibele Toll Plaza on

NH-44, the single journey toll for cars continues at ₹40, but the same-day multiple journey toll has increased from ₹55 to ₹60.

Meanwhile, NICE Road has revised toll charges across all vehicle categories, with cars and two-wheelers seeing an average increase of around 10%, depending on the entry and exit points and the distance travelled. Toll rates have been rounded to the nearest rupee.

// Last year, while celebrating Pi Approximation Day, I wrote about the joy hidden inside circles. This year, I'd like to talk about something even more fascinating—not the number itself, but the questions it leaves behind." One question from a student has stayed with me ever since. "Ma'am, if pi never ends, how do we know we've found the right answer?"

I smiled, because perhaps that is the beauty of mathematics. Sometimes, the goal isn't to reach the last digit. Sometimes, it is simply to keep exploring. Pi reminds us that not everything in life has a neat ending. Its digits continued endlessly, never repeating, quietly chal-

lenging every generation of mathematicians. Yet despite its infinite nature, this mysterious number helps us design bridges, predict planetary motion, create life-saving medical technology, and understand the world around us. As teachers, we often celebrate correct answers. But Pi teaches a different lesson. It celebrates curiosity. It tells us that asking "Why?" can be just as valuable as knowing "What?" "Perhaps that is why Pi has fascinated humanity for thousands of years. It isn't merely a mathematical constant; it is a reminder that knowledge has no finish line. As another Pi Approximation Day arrives, I hope children don't

just remember 22/7. I hope they remember the courage to ask one more question, explore one more idea, and discover one more pattern. Because in the end, education isn't about reaching the final answer. It's about never losing the curiosity to keep searching.

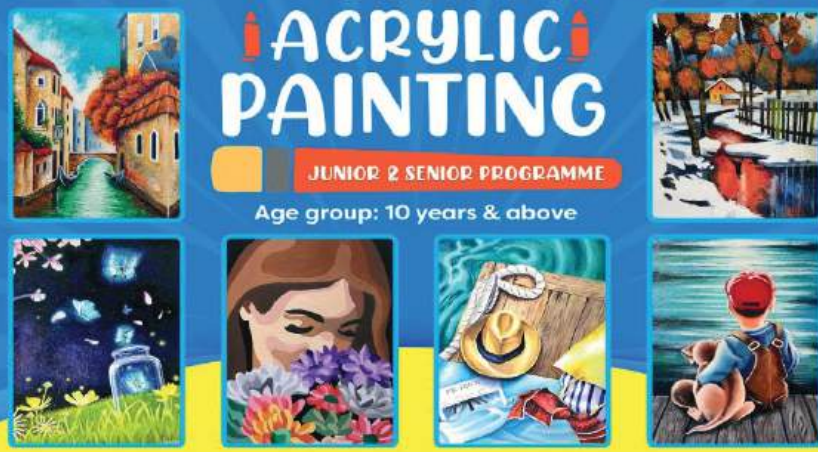
